Background on Review of Your Plans

Composition

The following people will serve on the Architectural Review committee:

Albrecht Herholdt (architect), Hedwig Crooijmans (urban designer) and a representative from the New Horizon Development Trust (client).

The task of the review committee will be to:

- Provide a briefing on the design code book if requested this cost will be calculated on a time and cost
- basis.
- Look at general appropriateness of the designs;
- Check the plans submitted in terms of coherence with the design code book;
- Provide written approval to the client submitting plans, if the plans comply.

What needs to be submitted to the Review Panel

The following documentation will have to be submitted in hard copy format:

- No. of units to be constructed
- A copy of the Regulation plan as illustrated in the New Horizon Villages Design Code Book.
- A copy of the Concept plan as illustrated in the New Horizon Villages Design Code Book.
- Floor plan 1:50/1:100
- Roof plan with dimension 1:100
- Site plan indicating the position of the unit in the neighbourhood and neighbouring units [if any]
- Contour plan indicating bulk earthworks cut and fill [if any]
- Section [s] 1:100 or 1:50
- All elevations 1:100 indicating materials, floor and roof dimensions
- Storm water management detail [if any]
- Finishing schedules including indication of colours
- Details on erf boundaries, walls, gates, including dimensions, materials and colour
- Owner's declaration or letter from architect confirming appointment for supervision
- Details of Architect and Developer/Owner
- Prescribed SACAP project form signed by owner and architect
- Architect and Owner to sign all plans and specification sheets

Submission Procedure

- Plans have to drawn up by a professional architect.
- Plans have to be submitted in hardcopy to the offices of EAS and payment for submission should be accompanied.
- The committee will sit on a two-weekly basis. Maximum response time is 3 weeks. Approvals can be expected every second and last Friday of the month.
- Incomplete submission will not be accepted.
- Submission fees apply for every re-submission.
- The architectural review committee has the authority to approve plans or request a revision from the architects.
- The committee will provide a written response to the Client submitting plans.
- Approval by the Review committee is a pre-requisite for Municipal Building Plan approval.

<u>Cost</u>

The cost (ex VAT) for submission is as following:

- Individual housing unit R 950 each
- Block of up to 6 units R 500 each
- Block of up to 20 units R 400 each

Payment in cash or a guaranteed check must be made out to The Matrix Architects who will provide an invoice and receipt.
